Aim

The IRM North East Regional Group supports this statement and aims to proactively embed the ethos of risk management within the North East.

Objectives

The IRM North East Regional Group objectives are to:-

- Facilitate open debate and constructively challenge risk management processes and practices with a view to sharing best practice;
- Continue to develop and increase North East Regional Group membership ensuring it meets the needs of its members;
- Raise awareness of the benefits risk management brings to organisations large and small within the North East; and
- Encourage the adoption of risk management tools and techniques in both private and public organisations.
