Minute:

1. Welcome by Laura Anne McMahon and thanks to Anne Storm for her hospitality.
2. As no one attended to present we had a quick introduction from everyone.
3. Brief discussion regarding the IRM Diploma exams being over at long last as Laura Anne McMahon was the only student present.
4. Presentation from Archie Mitchell, who has been a Health & Safety Inspector with the Health & Safety Executive (HSE), Glasgow, for the last 12 years. Archie spoke about his experience working with Local Authorities, the Police and Fire Services and also NHS organisations. Archie gave an interesting presentation on some of the cases he had been involved in. He also mentioned that under the new FOI Act, the HSE were 3rd highest for volume of requests for disclosure of information. In attending incidents, it was most important that evidence is preserved and this was one of the first police activities. Archie also advised that the HSE had introduced a "FIT3" project (fit for work, fit for life, fit for tomorrow) in line with their increased focus on proactive reduction. 5. Laura Anne McMahon asked the group if they were happy with the meetings being held at 1pm on a Friday and if there were any topics they would like to see covered.
